the first thing you will notice when you meet kechi okwuchi is her scars one of just two survivors of a devastating plane crash that killed more than 100 people 16 year old kechi was left with third degree burns over 65 percent of her body more than my scars is her incredible story a story of not just surviving impossible odds but thriving in a world that is too often caught up with how we look on the outside rather than seeing that our true value is within now in her early 30s kechi has spent the last 16 years refusing to be defined by her trauma follow her as she decides for herself what role her scars will play in her life before society decides for her her strong sense of identity rooted in seeing herself the way god sees her has allowed her to live authentically in a world that constantly seeks to define us by its ever changing and ever shallow standards kechi s story will inspire you to love and accept yourself as you are and confidently present your true self to the world

themselves in unfamiliar terrain and the choices are not always clear there are a wide variety of personalities and situations they have gotten into but they all find a way forward a comedian wants to be taken seriously in his old age a 60 year old robot has high aspirations when he is rebooted the proprietress of a dodge city saloon tries to write a memoir and a food critic learns to enjoy food again these stories and more explore different ways that the changes of mid life and beyond can be navigated

this book is the first complete intellectual biography of hermann cohen 1842 1918 and the only work to cover all his major philosophical and jewish writings frederick c beiser pays special attention to all phases of cohen s intellectual development its breaks and its continuities throughout seven decades the guiding goal behind cohen s intellectual career he argues was the development of a radical rationalism one committed to defending the rights of unending enquiry and unlimited criticism cohen s philosophy was therefore an attempt to defend and revive the enlightenment belief in the authority of reason his critical idealism an attempt to justify this belief and to establish a purely rational worldview according to this interpretation cohen s thought is resolutely opposed to any form of irrationalism or mysticism because these would impose arbitrary and artificial limits on criticism and enquiry it is therefore critical of those interpretations which see cohen s philosophy as a species of proto existentialism rosenzweig or jewish mysticism adelman and köhnke hermann cohen an intellectual biography attempts to unify the two sides of cohen s thought his philosophy and his judaism maintaining that cohen s judaism was not a limit to his radical rationalism but a consistent development of it beiser contends that his religion was one of reason he concludes that most critical interpretations have failed to appreciate the philosophical depth and sophistication of his judaism a religion which committed the believer to the unending search for truth and the striving to achieve the cosmopolitan ideals of reason
