Critically, RNA polymerase synthesizes RNA in the 5' to 3' direction. This means it adds new nucleotides to the 3' end of the growing RNA molecule. This is a fundamental constraint; RNA polymerase cannot add nucleotides to the 5' end. This directional constraint is crucial for the fidelity and efficiency of the transcription process.

4. Template Strand and Coding Strand:

Defining the Direction

DNA has two strands: the template strand (also called the antisense strand) and the coding strand (also called the sense strand). RNA polymerase uses the template strand as a guide. The RNA molecule synthesized will be complementary to the template strand and will have the same sequence as the coding strand (except uracil (U) replaces thymine (T) in RNA). This RNA molecule will be identical to the coding strand (except for the U instead of T). Notice that the RNA polymerase moved along the template strand from 3' to 5', resulting in RNA synthesis from 5' to 3'.

5. Consequences of Directional Transcription

The 5' to 3' directionality of RNA polymerase dictates several aspects of gene expression: Promoter Recognition: RNA polymerase must bind to a specific region of DNA called the promoter before initiating transcription. The orientation of the promoter determines the direction of transcription. Termination Signals: Transcription ends when RNA polymerase reaches a termination signal.
