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The Ships Sunk and Damaged at Pearl Harbor: A Detailed Account

The Nevada, for example, was underway during the attack and attempted to escape, but was hit by bombs before being beached to prevent sinking.

Other Vessel Losses and Damage

Beyond the battleships, the Japanese attack also resulted in significant damage and losses to other types of vessels. These included: Destroyers: Several destroyers suffered varying degrees of damage, reflecting the wide-ranging nature of the attack.
