the united states has been fighting wars constantly since invading afghanistan in 2001 this nonstop warfare is far less exceptional than it might seem the united states has been at war or has invaded other countries almost every year since independence in the united states of war david vine traces this pattern of bloody conflict from columbus s 1494 arrival in guantanamo bay through the 250 year expansion of a global us empire drawing on historical and firsthand anthropological research in fourteen countries and territories the united states of war demonstrates how us leaders across generations have locked the united states in a self perpetuating system of permanent war by constructing the world's largest ever collection of foreign military bases a global matrix that has made offensive interventionist wars more likely beyond exposing the profit making desires political interests racism and toxic masculinity underlying the country's relationship to war and empire the united states of war shows how the long history of us military expansion shapes our daily lives from today s multi trillion dollar wars to the pervasiveness of violence and militarism in everyday us life the book concludes by confronting the catastrophic toll of american wars which have left millions dead wounded and displaced while offering proposals for how we can end the fighting

the united states spearheaded the creation of many international organizations and treaties after

world war ii and maintains a strong record of compliance across several issue areas yet it also refuses to ratify major international conventions like the un convention on the law of the sea and the convention on the elimination of all forms of discrimination against women why does the united states often seem to support international law in one way while neglecting or even violating it in another the united states and international law paradoxes of support across contemporary issues analyzes the seemingly inconsistent u s relationship with international law by identifying five types of state support for international law leadership consent internalization compliance and enforcement each follows different logics and entails unique costs and incentives accordingly the fact that a state engages in one form of support does not presuppose that it will do so across the board the contributors to this volume examine how and why the united states has engaged in each form of support across twelve issue areas that are central to twentieth and twenty first century u s foreign policy conquest world courts war nuclear proliferation trade human rights war crimes torture targeted killing maritime law the environment and cybersecurity in addition to offering rich substantive discussions of u s foreign policy in each of these areas their findings reveal patterns across the u s relationship with international law that shed light on behavior that often seems paradoxical at best hypocritical at worst the results help us understand why the united states engages with international law as it does the legacies of the trump administration and what we should expect from the united states under the biden administration and beyond

unassuming but formidable american maritime insurers used their position at the pinnacle of global trade to shape the new nation the international information they gathered and the capital they generated enabled them to play central roles in state building and economic development during the revolution they helped the u s negotiate foreign loans sell state debts and establish a single national bank afterward they increased their influence by lending money to the federal government and to its citizens even as federal and state governments began to encroach on their domain maritime insurers adapted preserving their autonomy and authority through extensive involvement in the formation of commercial law leveraging their claims to unmatched expertise they operated free from government interference while simultaneously embedding themselves into the nation s institutional fabric by the early nineteenth century insurers were no longer just risk assessors they were nation builders and market makers deeply and imaginatively researched underwriters of the united states uses marine insurers to reveal a startlingly original story of risk money and power in the founding era

in a campaign for state or local office these days you re as likely today to hear accusations that an opponent advanced obamacare or supported donald trump as you are to hear about issues affecting the state or local community this is because american political behavior has become substantially more nationalized american voters are far more engaged with and knowledgeable about what s happening in washington dc than in similar messages whether they are in the south the northeast or the midwest gone are the days when all politics was local with the increasingly united states daniel j hopkins explores this trend and its implications for the american political system the change is significant in part because it works against a key rationale of america s federalist system which was built on the assumption that citizens would be more strongly attached to their states and localities it also has profound implications for how voters are represented if voters are well informed about state politics for example the governor has an incentive to deliver what voters or at least a pivotal segment of them want but if voters are likely to back the same party in gubernatorial as in presidential elections irrespective of the governor s actions in office governors may instead come to see their ambitions as tethered more closely to their status in the national party
