this medieval georgian text recounts the life of king giorgi and his daughter tamar who ascended the throne after his death giorgi known for his benevolence and support of the church was deeply saddened by his lack of children until tamar was born following giorgi s death tamar was celebrated for her beauty and virtue and the nobles quickly supported her ascension to the throne as queen tamar demonstrated wisdom and a commitment to faith initiating reforms to strengthen orthodoxy in her kingdom her reign is marked by her ability to discern loyalty and deceit and she sought to eradicate evil influences within her realm

cheryl anderson examines the laws relating to women that are found in the book of the covenant and the deuteronomic law she argues that the laws can be divided into those that treat women similarly to men defined as inclusive laws and those that treat women differently exclusive laws she then suggests that the exclusive laws which construct gender as male dominance female subordination do not just describe violence against women but are inherently violent toward women as a non historical critique of ideology critical theory is used to offer

analytical insights that have significant implications for understanding gender constructions in both ancient and contemporary settings

the context of new and contemporary challenges in theory and practice these essays show an evolution of issues and frameworks for theology care and activism arising over time from the movement to end violence against women both within and beyond religious communities while at the same time demonstrating an unchanging core commitment to gender justice

questions related to the issue of gender remain insufficiently acknowledged and explored in contemporary theological literature these issues form the basis of significant unresolved tensions among evangelicals as evidenced in debates over the nature of the trinity bible translation church practice choice of language mission leadership decision making in homes and parenting to name but a few examples the essays in this volume are not meant to provide a monolithic evangelical theology of gender but rather to provide evangelical perspectives surrounding the topic of gender to further this aim each of the main essays is followed by a formal response with an attempt at a concise and lucid perspective on the essay and pointers to further areas for investigation some contributors are complementarian while others are egalitarian although who is what is left to the discerning reader regardless of one's position on the issue all will benefit from the contributors commitment to the further exploration of gender issues from the perspective of a broadly conceived evangelicalism

this work lies at the critical juncture of feminism and religious studies and participates in the vibrant tradition of the feminist anthology it is part of a broad feminist discourse that continues to grow less monolithic and more varied in material method and style each year the papers are divided into three main sections the representation of women in sacred texts and theologies the fundamental need to recover the heritage of women and to return to women their history and the coming together of canonical texts with contemporary feminist theory in order to address philosophical and theological problems

april westbrook explores the intentional inclusion of woman stories those displaying significant female presence within the david narrative in the books of samuel these stories are made prominent by the surprisingly high number of their occurrences as well as the sequentially progressive literary pattern in which they occur in the larger narrative westbrook shows that the dramatic and detailed accounts within the story repeatedly challenge the reader to consider the experiences of women and their contribution to the purpose of the larger narrative when viewed collectively these woman stories serve to stir the reader's responses in ways which systematically call into question the nature of the monarchy itself as a power system both its impact upon the nation and upon the kings who rule although king david is often held up as a paragon of virtue the experiences of the women in his life frequently reveal a different side of his character and the reader must wrestle with the resultant ambiguity in the process the reader must also think deeply about the inevitably negative aspects of hierarchical social structures and why this biblical text is apparently designed to press the reader toward unavoidable and uncomfortable personal confrontation with these realities concerning the use of power within community life

the bible and gender based violence in botswana foregrounds the rampancy of gender based violence against women and girls in biblical texts and how it resonates with gender based violence gbv in the author's contemporary context of botswana the volume reads selected texts from the bible alongside newspaper reports of gbv against women and girls in botswana to show that while the bible is taken as an authoritative text within the botswana context it is riddled with gbv against female persons it asserts that by acknowledging and naming gbv in biblical texts and not concealing ignoring or spiritualizing it contemporary communities of faith will be able to confront the problem in these contexts by so doing the book argues the bible will become a resource for positive transformation rather than a tool for supporting gender injustice
